Dear Councillor

I write to update you on the consultation to change the above street name to Frank Bangay Way.

We have now had responses from 8 properties in Bangays Way (either from the owners or from the purchasers in the process of acquiring the property). Of these responses 3 have no objection to the proposal, and 5 object. I should add that one of these objections came from Crest, who own the showhome in Bangays Way but are nevertheless entitled to express a view on the proposed change.

I am also aware that you have all expressed no objection to the proposed name change, as has the Parish Council.

Paragraph 5.3 of the Council's street naming and numbering policy requires that any change to a street name will require a minimum of two thirds support from the local residents for any change as this can be very disruptive and cause individuals to have to change all of their personal address details. Therefore, on the results of the consultation, there is insufficient support for the proposed name change to Frank Bangay Way and the street name will remain Bangays Way.

We shall be notifying all consultees shortly, but I wanted to give you advance notice as ward members. I have also let Tom Tugendhat MP know the outcome of the consultation.
