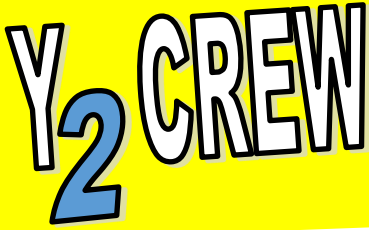
For young people aged 8-18 years

Art & Craft Sessions

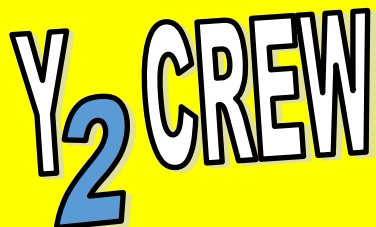
Week 1 – Catch a rainbow with dreamcatchers, fancy plant pots and party poppers.

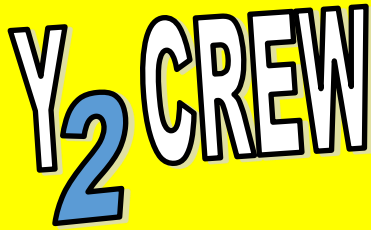
